Prayer Focus April – June 2021 (NKJV)

“Praying for a Christ Awakening in the Church and the Salvation of Souls for Christ”

“Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or imagine according to the power that works in us, to Him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus to all generations forever and ever. Amen.” Ephesians 3:20-21

God’s desire is for us to be led by His Spirit as we unite our hearts with His, praying according to His good, acceptable, and perfect will. **Romans 12:2** These prayer requests are not meant to be confining or exclusive. Our prayer is that they will bring God’s truth to your heart and will encourage you to boldly pray what is on His heart specifically for your city and nation on each topic, anticipating a manifestation of His Spirit in your city and nation greater than you have ever known for His glory! **Romans 11:36**

1. Churches and Ministers *“When I shut up heaven and there is no rain, or command the locusts to devour the land, or send pestilence among My people, if My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land.” 2 Chronicles 7:13-14*

- Ask God to give church Ministers a fresh revelation of the times in our Nation, and that we will act on God’s message to them. **Ecclesiastes 3: 1-8, 17; 2 Timothy 4:2, Exodus 9:16**
- Pray for Christ’s followers to make prayer a priority, to seek His face, repent of doing things our way and to humbly serve others. **Matthew 5:6, Isaiah 57:15, 1 Peter 3:15**

2. Families *“He did not waver at the promise of God through unbelief, but was strengthened in faith, giving glory to God, and being fully convinced that what He had promised He was also able to perform.” Romans 4:20-21*

- Ask God to give parents hope as they have faith in Him and trust His word. Pray parents would set an example to their children to pray and trust God in all things. **Philippians 4:8, Proverbs 3:5-6**

3. Government & Military *“... I exhort first that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks be made for all men, for kings and all who are in authority, that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence. For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.” 1 Tim. 2:1-4*

- Pray for the House of Representatives, the Senate, President Biden, and the Supreme Court to do what is moral and right in God’s sight and protect the unborn. **Proverbs 21:1, Psalm 33:12**
- Ask God to give government officials (city, state, and national) His wisdom so that none will be able to resist or contradict them; and that Christ’s Spirit will be known among them. **Exodus 31:3, Luke 21:15**
- Pray for God’s spiritual, physical and emotional protection for our government officials, military leaders, and their families. **Psalm 91:11**
- Pray that every Christ follower will vote biblically for the candidates who honor God. **Deuteronomy 26:18**

4. Education *“Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid. John 14: 27*

- Ask God to give all those who teach children His peace that passes all understanding and an unspeakable joy, and they would be witnesses for Him. **Philippians 4:6-7, Psalm 89:15**

5. Business *“May He grant you according to your heart’s desire and fulfill all your purpose.” Psalm 20:4*

- Pray for each believer to rise up and serve the purposes of God in the sector of society in which they work.

6. Arts, Media, and Entertainment *“Lead me in Your truth and teach me, for You are the God of my salvation...” Psalm 25:5*

- Pray for biblical truth, objectivity, and unbiased reporting from all media.

7. Special Issues Concerning Your City and Nation *“Do you not say, ‘There are still four months and then comes the harvest? Behold, I say to you, life up your eyes and look at the fields, for they are already white for harvest!’ John 4:35*

- Pray that 2021, will be a year for Christians to “pray-in” the harvest of souls and evangelize in word and deed. **2 Peter 3:9**
- Pray that in LPI’s 24th year that men and women Lighthouses of Prayer will pray in unity and God’s glory will spread across the city and nation. **Romans 4:20-21**
- Ask God to give Christians the desire to share the gospel with others in word a deed. **Luke 9:56; 2 Peter 3:9**
- Pray for churches to start evangelism classes and that many from across the city would attend. **John 14:26**
- Pray for San Antonio’s local elections to be held May 1st and that Proposition B, which is a proposition to specifically defund the police department does not pass. A strongly funded police force keeps our city safe. *“And seek the peace of the city where I have caused you to be carried away captive and pray to the Lord for it; for in its peace you will have peace.” Jeremiah 29:7 Pray Psalm 3:3 for Chief McManus and Police officers. “But You, O LORD, are a shield for me, My glory and the One who lifts up my head.”*

8. Christian Organizations *“Unless the Lord builds the house, they labor in vain who build it.” Psalm 127:1*

- Pray for organizations on your heart to have God’s anointing power and the resources needed to further His will. **Rom. 11:36**

1) Ecclesiastes 3: 1 To everything *there is* a season, A time for every purpose under heaven:

Ecclesiastes 3: 17 I said in my heart, “God shall judge the righteous and the wicked, for *there is* a time there for every purpose and for every work.”

Timothy 4: 2 Preach the word! Be ready in season *and* out of season. Convince, rebuke, exhort, with all longsuffering and teaching.

Exodus 9: 16 But indeed for this *purpose* I have raised you up, that I may show My power *in* you, and that My name may be declared in all the earth.

Matthew 5: 6 Blessed *are* those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be filled.

Isaiah 57: 15 For thus says the High and Lofty One Who inhabits eternity, whose name *is* Holy: “I dwell in the high and holy place, with him *who* has a contrite and humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite ones.

1 Peter 3: 15 But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts, and always *be* ready to *give* a defense to everyone who asks you a reason for the hope that is in you, with meekness and fear;

2) Philippians 4: 8 Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things *are* noble, whatever things *are* just, whatever things *are* pure, whatever things *are* lovely, whatever things *are* of good report, if *there is* any virtue and if *there is* anything praiseworthy—meditate on these things.

Proverbs 3:5-6 Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct your paths.

3) Proverbs 21: 1 The king’s heart *is* in the hand of the Lord, *Like* the rivers of water; He turns it wherever He wishes.

Psalms 33: 12 Blessed *is* the nation whose God *is* the Lord, the people He has chosen as His own inheritance.

Exodus 31: 3 And I have filled him with the Spirit of God, in wisdom, in understanding, in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship,

Luke 21: 15 for I will give you a mouth and wisdom which all your adversaries will not be able to contradict or resist.

Psalms 91: 11 For He shall give His angels charge over you, to keep you in all your ways.

Deuteronomy 26: 18 Also today the LORD has proclaimed you to be His special people, just as He promised you, that you should keep all His commandments.

4) Philippians 4: 6-7 Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

Psalms 89: 15 Blessed *are* the people who know the joyful sound! They walk, O Lord, in the light of Your countenance.

7) 2 Peter 3: 9 The Lord is not slack concerning *His* promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.

Romans 4: 20-21 He did not waver at the promise of God through unbelief, but was strengthened in faith, giving glory to God, and being fully convinced that what He had promised He was also able to perform.

Luke 9: 56 For the Son of Man did not come to destroy men’s lives but to save *them*...
